Who is the playground for?

The playground is primarily designed for children aged 6-13 years but younger and older children may attend. Children under 6 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult. We strongly recommend that children under 8 are also accompanied.

There is a young helper scheme for children, if they wish to be involved with the running of the playground.

We run various groups and sessions for different ages during the week. Up to date information can be found on the website www.wisbechadventureplay.net

The playground is an inclusive provision and we welcome children of all abilities. When Playworkers are on site there is free use of:

- An all terrain wheelchair
- A mobile hoist for indoor and outdoor use

An accessible toilet and hygiene room

The playground is open access. This means that children are free to come and go as they please. Staff cannot take responsibility for ensuring children remain on site or escort them home.

How much does it cost?

It is absolutely **FREE** for individuals to attend!

All you need to do is fill in a membership form. This helps us to look after the children and young people at the playground and enables us to contact parents and carers in case of emergency.

How do I know my children are safe?

All staff have an enhanced CRB/DBS check. All staff have experience working with children and young people and have at least a Level 2 relevant qualification (or will be working towards it). There will always be at least two Playworkers on site during staffed sessions, usually more!

Will my child get dirty at the adventure playground?

It is quite possible that children and young people will get dirty. We offer a wide range of activities, some of which can be messy. We recommend that children wear clothes and footwear that can get dirty and are suitable for climbing and running around.

What are the opening hours?

Playworkers are usually at the playground after school Tuesday-Friday, on Saturdays and in school holidays. Times and days are sometimes subject to change at short notice so please check the website www.wisbechadventureplay.net for up to date information.

You are welcome to attend outside of these times, but there will be no staff here and therefore no toilet or first-aid facilities available. The playground is occasionally closed during the day for private sessions.

Details are always on the website so please check to avoid disappointment.
