

## Our Ethos

At the playground, activities are set up, Play is freely chosen, and we allow children to explore with their own ideas and in their own way. Staff are trained and skilled in this way of working and use a low intervention style. Research shows that working like this is a very effective way for children to learn and develop their skills and understanding. Playworkers and Family workers are at the stay and play session to support all children and their parents/carers in the creation of a space in which they can play and have lots of fun.

**What do family workers have to offer?**

We can: Signpost families to other services such as speech and language. The health team, housing and benefits and Funded 2's. Staff can also offer advice on issues such as sleep routines, toileting, behaviour strategies, feeding/weaning and breast feeding.


